## 3rd Grade Summer 2019 Packet

Get ready to BINGO!! It is fun and easy. In order to complete your summer packet, you must "COVERALL." This means that each and every square on the BINGO sheet must be initialed by a parent or guardian when completed along with having the appropriate items attached.

## SOME BASIC RULES:

- 1. KEEP TRACK of your BINGO Card!
- 2. Write the title of the book, magazine, or whatever you read, in the Bingo square, along with the DATE you finish it and have a parent initial it. You must have this information in the square in order for it to be counted.
- 3. <u>IMPORTANT NOTE</u>: Each thing you read can only <u>COUNT ONCE</u> on your card. (For example, if you read a picture book to your little brother, you can only count it as "Read a Picture Book to someone" OR "Read aloud to someone for 15 minutes." NOT BOTH. Another example: If you read a 200 page chapter book, you <u>CANNOT</u> mark off both of the "Read a chapter book with over 100 pages" squares.) Each square is its own independent reading, math, science or social studies activity—nothing overlaps.
- 4. Be sure to attach all items indicated or your Summer Packet will not be considered completed.
